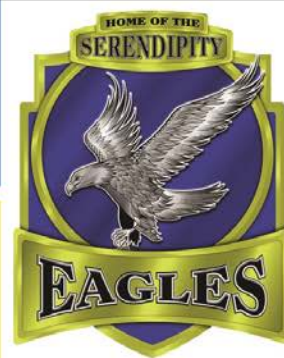

Now is your opportunity to become Serendipity Famous in TWO WAYS. Give the sauce a try and then:

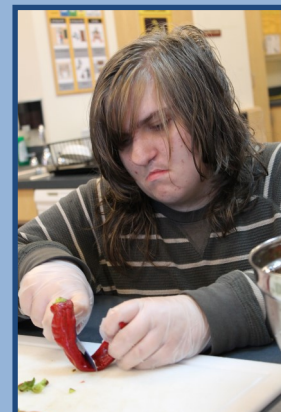
1. Draw a label that represents the hot sauce

2. Give the hot sauce a name

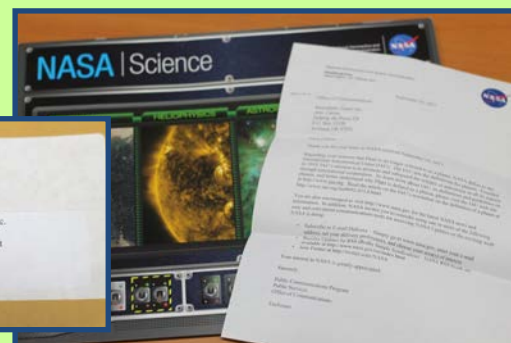
You may participate in one competition, or both. Give submissions to Arianna by Friday, November 17. Submissions will be put up for a staff vote.

Nicolas has been making a trademark hot sauce for Serendipity every fall for three years. Nicolas makes the sauce with peppers from the Growing Minds Garden, using different peppers for each batch, with this year's batch made from Nardello (a sweet Italian heirloom), Sandia (a NuMex Chili) and Fish (small, variegated & hot!). The only other ingredients are salt and time—this hot sauce has been fermented; it's probiotic, meaning it's packed with good bacteria (like sauerkraut & yogurt), which aid digestion and strengthen the immune system. The sauce gets put out at lunch, and used at Serendipity events. Look to the left to find out how you can be a part of Serendipity hot sauce history!

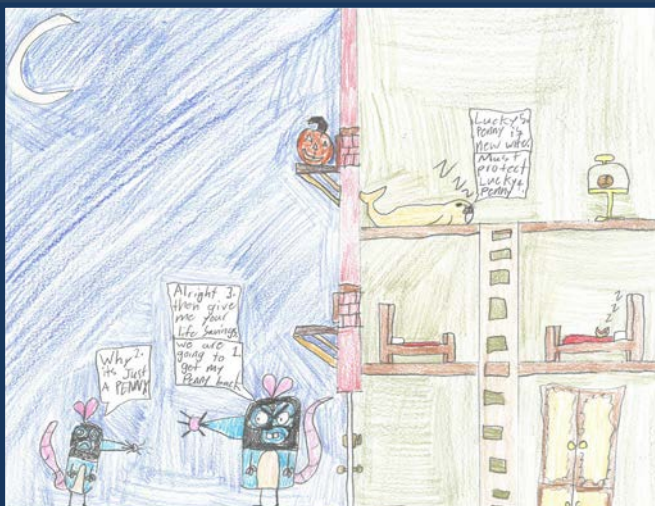
"Foxy! That's too big! IT'S GOING TO BLOW! CONTROL IT!" Mr. Killian exclaimed.
