Monday: Animal Personality Day

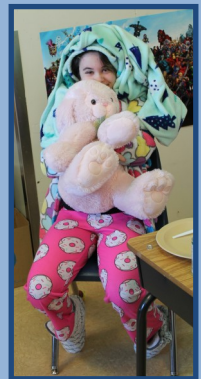
Tuesday: Pajama Day

This school is the best school to be at. Students that come to this school are very lucky and they have made the right choice. Parents, you should decide to send your kids here!

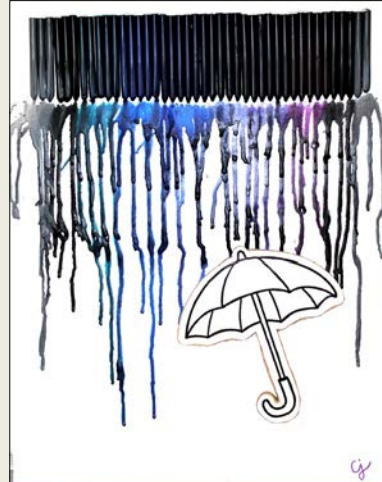

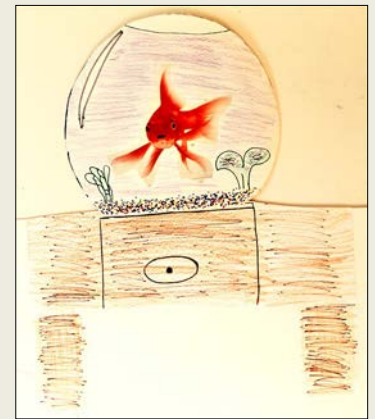

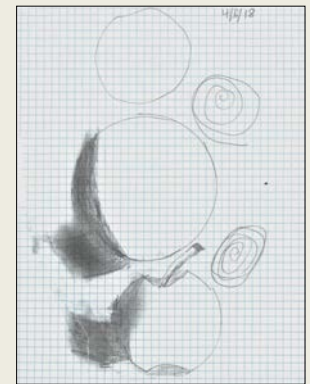
